



Objective of the Activity:	To provide students with valuable insights into financial planning, equipping them with the knowledge and skills needed to make informed decisions about investments, budgeting and managing expenses for a secure financial future.	
Summary of Activity:	The CII Yi Yuva Club of IIS (Deemed to be University), Jaipur, in collaboration with the Yi Jaipur Chapter, hosted an insightful guest lecture on Financial Planning on 18th September 2024. The session featured two distinguished speakers—Mr. Alok Sharma, Vice President of Sales at Bandhan AMC, currently heading the Rajasthan region, and Mr. Sachin Singhal, Founder of FinanceOne Consultants and Business Partner at Sharekhan Ltd., Jaipur.	
	The primary objective of the lecture was to equip students with essential knowledge and practical strategies for financial planning, enabling them to make informed decisions regarding investments, budgeting, and expense management. The session began with the screening of One Idiot—an Amole Gupte film and an IDFC Foundation initiative—which effectively set the tone for the discussions that followed.	
	Mr. Sachin Singhal emphasized the importance of saving and investing money rather than merely spending it. He encouraged students to consider investment avenues such as mutual funds and Systematic Investment Plans (SIPs), explaining how these options promote wealth generation through continuous capital circulation. He also introduced the concept of compounding—often referred to as the "snowball effect"—and highlighted its significant impact on long-term wealth accumulation.	
	Mr. Alok Sharma reinforced these ideas by delving deeper into practical financial strategies and underscored the importance of smart financial management. He shared valuable insights into personal finance, guiding students on how to manage their budgets effectively while building a solid financial foundation for the future.	
	Overall, the session proved to be highly enriching, offering students a clear understanding of how to plan, save, and invest wisely. It inspired them to take	

	proactive steps toward securing their financial well- being from an early stage in life.	
Outcome of the Activity:	The key takeaways included practical guidance on investments, savings, and the power of compounding, serving as a valuable roadmap for students to navigate their financial journeys. 
