WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY CELEBRATION

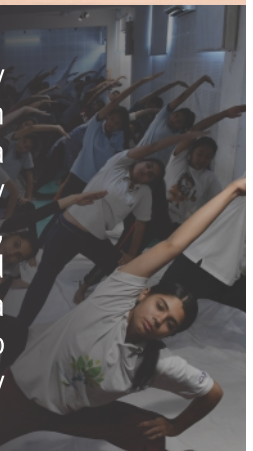
The Eco-friendly Association and Department of

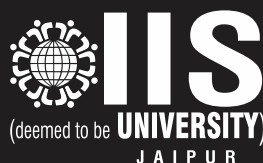
GUEST LECTURE
