## YOUTH EXCHANGE PROGRAMME

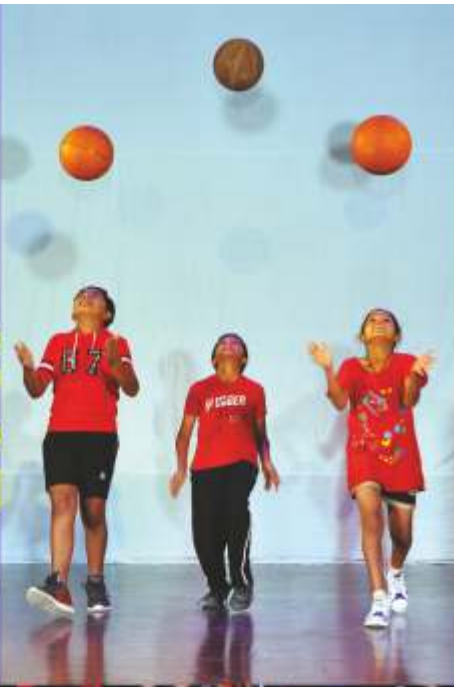
