**2** 3rd February 2017: Jaipur: The Department of English of The IIS University organized the Fourth All India IISU English Debate on the topic "Women make for better women than men" at The IIM auditorium. On the occasion, Ms. Kanta Ahuja, Former Vice-Chancellor, University of Rajasthan was the chairperson while IPS P.K.Tiwari, Ms. Rachana Singh, Journalist and Ms. Ruchi Bhargava Theatre Artist were among the panel of judges.

The university and colleges from across the country participated in the debate. It has given the participants a national platform to express themselves and hone their debating skills. As soon as chairperson declared the debate open, the young participants put forth their views with full conviction and confidence.

Apeksha Tikkoo, a student from The IIS University while speaking in favor of the motion said that there could be no better leader than a woman, but she is taken as an epitome of weakness and incompetence by the society. For everybody's information, there is another side to it. "Suppose, both woman and a man take part in a race. While woman is running with a heavy baggage of discrimination, sexism etc while a man is running with unburdened baggages using his full force to leave his counterpart behind. Now, both of them reach the finish line at the same time, who would you declare the winner." She asserted, one of the contestants took to help of a research to speak in the house of the motion. She said that a research conducted by an online company, found out that companies lead by women perform better than companies led by men. On the other hand, the contestants who spoke against the motion were equally convincing. One of the contestants stated that our country needs a practical leader and not one who basis his practicality on emotion.

Results were announced towards the end of the competition. Ms. Anupriya from Banasthali while speaking against the notion stood at third position while Ashi Goyal who spoke in against and Apeksha Tikkoo spoke in favor of the topic bagged second and first position respectively. Since winners were from the host team, so the team trophy went to Banasthali, Jaipur.

## Women Studies and Sociology on Safe and Happy Periods

**A** guest lecture was held for the students of Foundation Women Studies and Sociology on Safe and Happy Periods on Tuesday, 21st of February 2017. Ms. Sarika Gupta the founder of the initiative known as 'Safe n Happy Periods' interacted with the students about Menstruation. Reflecting upon her personal experiences and field work she discussed about the biological basis of menstruation, the need to discard superstitions and taboos around it. Adding she emphasized on the correct ways of using and disposing sanitary napkins and the resulting repercussions due to inappropriate disposal.

The thought provoking part was her revelation about the composition of napkins of popular brands like Whisper, Stayfree etc. which we have been using for years which have 90% plastic. Following it she showed newer

products which can be used instead of plastic napkins like tampons, menstrual cups, and cloth sanitary napkins.

She also stressed on wearing cotton clothes during periods and avoiding tight fitted clothing like jeans etc. Ms. Sarika also carried out live demonstration of two yogasanas namely SuptaBadhakonasana and UpvishtaKonasana which aid in abdominal pain and facilitate relaxation during periods. Towards the end she shared information about online websites like Ecofem and Aegis which sell biodegradable sanitary napkins which are safer and more comfortable than usual pads.

Ms. Chanda Asani faculty of Women's Studies presented Ms Sarika Gupta with a token of remembrance and affection.

## Union Budget 2017-2018 - Expectations & Outcome

**A** seminar on "Union Budget 2017-2018- Expectations & Outcome" was organized by the department of Department- HRM & IB on 9th February, 2017. It was divided into two sessions. In the first session a Panel Discussion was organized where experts from Industry and Academia gave their valuable inputs and insights related to the Union Budget 2017-18. In the second session, students presented their views on the budget and its impact on various sectors through PowerPoint presentations.

The first speaker was Prof. Vijay Vir Singh, an eminent personality in the field of Economics highlighted the fact that the new government is going for huge public expenditure. Therefore, government should adopt such policies which would reduce government deficit.

The second speaker was CA Rajeew Sogani, acquainted the students with different aspects of tax amendments in the light of Union Budget 2017-18. The third speaker was Prof Som Deo, UGC Fellow Emeritus, Dept.of EAFM, University of Rajasthan Jaipur, highlighted that the economic survey is very complex and difficult to be understood by the common citizen. He also emphasized on the fact that today economic policies are unable to deliver their promise. Shri Sogani said that Budget 2017-18 is focusing more on digitalization and aims to boost digital economy. He threw light on Presumptive Taxation.
