4. Prof. Ashok Gupta:

- He informed the Board members that AICTE has granted approval for starting of MBA (180 seats), MCA (60 seats) and a new programme MBA (Innovation, Entrepreneurship & Venture Development) (30 seats), programmes from the academic session 2020-21. He further informed that university also offers MBA-Trimester scheme programme which is co-educational. It is proposed to bifurcate 180 seats in the different specialized programmes of MBA, as given below:.
- He further informed the members that the attendance was more than 90% in online classes taken by the faculty members during lockdown period.
- He also informed that due to COVID-19 pandemic, the university has conducted online examination for Semester End Examination April 2020, with a rider that any student who is unable to take online exam can take pen-paper examination as and when scheduled. The online examination pattern was based on MCQs.
- So far the feed-back for online examination is good and no complaints have been received from the students.
- With this the University will be able to declare the result in time
