A one day workshop was organized by IIS University, Jaipur, a Remote Centre of IIT Bombay outreach programme, in collaboration with IIT Bombay on the "Moodle Learning Management System" under the Train 10,000 Teachers (T10KT) programme, sponsored by the National Mission on Education through ICT (NMEICT), Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India to be held on Friday, 15 March 2019 from 9.30 AM to 6.00 PM. The workshop was conducted through a blended mode, using both live video conferencing facility (A-VIEW) and Hands-on sessions at the remote centre. Prof. Kannan Moudgalya was the main coordinator of the workshop. He is the principal investigator of PMMMNMTT and Spoken Tutorial Project. At IIS remote center workshop was coordinated by Dr Amita Sharma and Mr Harvansh Singh.

FDP101x: Foundation Programme in ICT for Education

Duration: 13 September-18 October 2018

IIS (deemed to be University), Jaipur has participated as a remote centre in Faculty Development Programme (FDP) conducted by IIT Bombay in a blended MOOC approach (Duration 13 Sept to 18 Oct 2018). This course was focused on developing awareness about both technology and effective practices of integrating technology in to teaching-learning. The major course objectives were to identify ICT tools for teaching-learning, bring awareness towards ethical practices for use in ICT education and best practices for information dissemination using ICT. The instructors were Prof. Deepak B. Phatak, Dr. Jayakrishnan M, Prof. Prabhakar T V and Dr. Sameer S Sahasrabudhe from IIT Bombay. Total 41 candidates were registered for FDP out of which 38 were faculty members of IIS (deemed to be University), Jaipur. The FDP was divided in to five weeks and participants were graded for knowledge quiz, assimilation quiz, reflection quiz released for each week. Grading was also given for resource creation assignment, lab activities followed by a summative assessment at the end of course. 39 participants enrolled in FDP successfully completed the course.

The key learning's were concept of Learner Centric MOOC model that included incorporation of different pedagogic adaptations like learning dialogues (LeD), learning by doing activity (LbD), reflection stops, learning extension resources, (LxT), learning experience interactions (LxI) and discussion forums in teaching learning. During the course, participants learned the use of wordpress, dropbox, googlecloud, screencast etc., to design resources and activities for teaching-learning in their own subjects. They were able to create their own website using wordpress. Screencast was used to prepare teaching material and upload the same on Moodle site. Weekwise course journal was also prepared and uploaded on wordpress site by each participant. The FDP also had AVIEW interaction session for lab assignment which was conducted on Sunday 7 Oct 2018 in the University campus from 9:30- 5:30. In this session, participants were assigned two lab assignments. They also interacted with participants of other remote centres via AVIEW software. The ICT tools learned in this FDP made participants technology friendly so that they can use them in their day to day teaching learning activities.

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At the outset, the dean, Prof. Pradeep Bhatnagar welcomed all the members of the BOS.

Prof. R. K. Bansal chaired the session. The syllabus for the MSc Chemistry is considered for discussion. Initially all the members discussed about the credit template, scheme of examinations, title of papers and practical papers. Suggestions made after the discussion are-

- 1. Change in the Credit template was proposed. It was suggested to keep the credits of all the semester almost equal. Respective modifications were suggested. Major change in the credit of the dissertation of MSc Sem IV i.e. reduced from 20 to 10.
- 2. A change in the scheme of the examination was proposed. It was suggested to merge Research methodology paper with Seminar CHY 227. Respective change in the scheme of examination of this paper was suggested.
- 3. Dr Tanmoy Chakraborty suggested incorporating Course out come and programme outcome. He also suggested to use the references in two sections- Text books and suggested readings.
- 4. In laboratory course, a new paper was proposed on laboratory safety for the 1st year students, to improve laboratory awareness. It was proposed to include it as compulsory paper. In laboratory course it was suggested to use micro kits. There are some suggestions for the shuffling of the content. Particularly for Seminar, it was suggested to use language laboratory for Seminar.
- 5. Some other suggestions are as follows-
- It was suggested to introduce some new papers.
- Modifications in the title of some papers were suggested.
- It was suggested to remove green chemistry content from Environmental and green chemistry paper and the title of the paper was changed to Environmental chemistry.

There after all the members were dispersed in three groups- Inorganic, Organic and physical according to their respective fields. The discussion continued in groups on the next day. After lunch all the groups assembled and discussed the suggestions. The meeting ended with a vote of thanks.



It gives us immense pleasure to inform you that a National Seminar on Women's Employment, Entrepreneurship and Empowerment: Sustainable Pathways to Egalitarian Society' sponsored by ICSSR, New Delhi, is being organized by The Centre for Research, Innovation and Training (CRIT), The IIS University, Jaipur, on 30-31 January, 2017.

One of the most meaningful and famous quotes by the Former Prime Minister Smt. Indira Gandhi for Women Empowerment is "To be liberalized, women must be free to be themselves in the context of their capacity and personality. Any society cannot progress if half of its members, the women, do not have equal opportunities and their talents and capabilities are ignored." Women Empowerment is the process of challenging existing power relations and gaining control over resources in the society. Economic dependence of women is one of the major obstacles in the path of empowerment of women in contemporary Indian society. As per Census 2011, the workforce participation rate for females at the national level stands at 25.51% compared with 53.26% for males. In the rural sector, females have a workforce participation rate of 30.02% compared with 53.03% for males. In the urban sector, it is 15.44% for females and 53.76% for males (NSSO Report, 2013). This indicates that there is a marked difference in the work participation rates of males and females. As far as the work participation rate is concerned, the institutionalization of mother -housewife role is the primary reason for subordination of women in the occupational structure. Lack of mobility, invisibility and cultural taboos related to patriarchy are the other specific constraints faced by women. Moreover, women in India are not a homogenous group. There are urban, rural and tribal women. Each of these segments have different sets of structural and cultural problems. The status of rural and tribal women is lower than their urban counterparts, in terms of access to knowledge and resources. Women also tend to get displaced by new technologies and in this context skill development for employment and entrepreneurship assume key importance. The concept of women empowerment is rooted in the economic status of women. This status emerges with capacity building and skill development which promotes self-reliance. Women's participation in the work force is regarded as an index of empowerment. The changing economic and social conditions in the society due to forces of globalization present new challenges and opportunities for women, which have to be dealt with in a pragmatic manner. Entrepreneurship and employment are critical to enhance the status of women. The state interventions to redress the problem of gender imbalance and gender mainstreaming have to be coupled with coordinated and concrete efforts from all segments of society. It is imperative to understand the opportunities and challenges of women's employment and entrepreneurship in any evaluation of nature and pattern of social changes in the status of women in contemporary Indian society. The seminar has been planned to achieve the following objectives:

- To discuss the government policies and societal efforts to promote women entrepreneurship and employment.
- To explore the new avenues of employment of women in service sector.
- To explore sustainable pathways for development of egalitarian society.
- To address the social and economic issues pertaining to women empowerment.
