



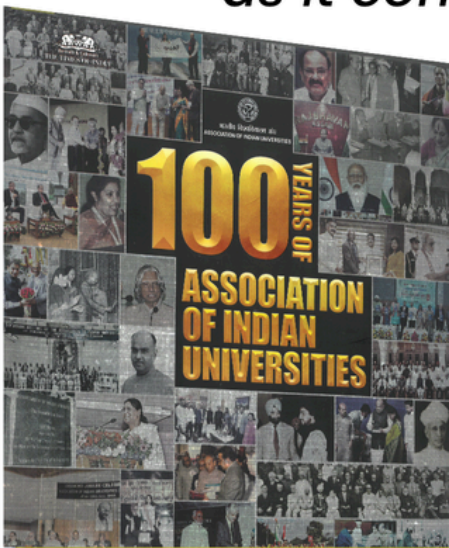

Under the stewardship of our late Vice-Chancellor, **Dr. Ashok Gupta**, IIS University had the privilege of hosting the **AIU West Zone Vice Chancellors' Meet**, in 2019.

Focused on the "Internationalization of Higher Education and Global Rankings", the event was a testament to Dr. Gupta's commitment to placing our institution on the global map. Distinguished guests - including Governor Sh. Kalraj Mishra - graced the occasion which was featured in a coffee table book released by AIU this year.

Now in its centenary year, we are happy to have contributed to AIU's ongoing journey of academic excellence and continue to be an integral part of the Association .

International Conference

An International Conference on Biotechnology and Nanotechnology (ICBN-2025) was organised by the Department of Microbiology and Biotechnology, IIS (Deemed to be University), on 30 October - 1 November 2025. The conference was conceptualised as a multidisciplinary platform bringing together academicians, scientists, researchers, and students from India and abroad both in online and offline mode to discuss emerging trends and contemporary advancements in biotechnology and nanoscience. The conference received financial support from Department of Biotechnology (DBT), Govt. of India and Council for Scientific and Industrial research (CSIR), India. Over the span of three days, distinguished experts shared their insights on molecular medicine, nanotechnology, vaccine development, genetic research, and environmental sustainability.



Non-Communicable Disease Screening Mega Camp

The National Service Scheme (NSS) unit of the University organised a Non-Communicable Disease (NCD) Screening Mega Camp in collaboration with Eternal Hospital with the objective of promoting health awareness and preventive care among the institution's community members. The mega camp aimed at identifying and preventing non-communicable diseases (NCDs) such as hypertension, diabetes, and other lifestyle-related ailments, which are becoming increasingly prevalent due to changing work habits and sedentary lifestyles. The initiative reflected the NSS motto of "Not Me But You", emphasizing the spirit of social responsibility and community well-being.

The camp received an enthusiastic response from all sections of the institution. A total of 97 individuals—including faculty members, teaching and non-teaching staff, peons, and drivers—participated and benefitted from the free health check-up services. The medical team from Eternal Hospital provided on-site health screening facilities, including blood pressure (BP) monitoring and blood sugar testing. These tests were crucial in detecting early signs of hypertension and diabetes, enabling timely medical consultation and lifestyle modification.



Samyukta 2025

The Performing Arts Department organized a vibrant and engaging cultural showcase Samyukta 2025 on 4th Nov, that highlighted the immense talent and creativity of students from Kathak Dance, Folk Dance, and Theatre Studies. The event brought together diverse art forms on one stage, celebrating tradition, expression, and performance excellence.

The Kathak Dance students opened the evening with an impressive presentation of Taal, displaying their rhythmic footwork, graceful movements, and command over layakari. Their tukdas and tatkars were executed with precision, showcasing both their dedication to practice and their deep understanding of classical technique. This was followed by a lively and colourful performance by the Folk Dance students, who presented a traditional Rajasthani folk dance set to energetic and soulful folk songs. The evening concluded with an engaging theatrical performance by the Theatre Studies students, who staged A Matter of Husbands by Ferenc Molnár.



Abhivyakti: Ek Prayaas

The School of Fine Arts at IIS (deemed to be University), successfully hosted the 23rd edition of its acclaimed Annual Art Exhibition, Abhivyakti Ek Prayaas. Spanning over two decades, this creative tradition remains a vital platform for nurturing and showcasing the extraordinary talent of young artists. The latest iteration of this significant event took place at Jawahar Kala Kendra, Jaipur, from November 7 to November 11, 2025, marking yet another milestone in the university's commitment to artistic exploration.

The exhibition commenced with a distinguished opening ceremony, the event was inaugurated by Chief Guest Shri Rajesh Kumar Yadav, IAS, an officer of the 1996 batch (Rajasthan cadre) who has held key roles, including Principal Secretary for departments like Tourism, Art, Literature, Culture & Archaeology, and Director General of Jawahar Kala Kendra. The Guest of Honour was Shri Prayag Shukla, a highly regarded Indian poet, fiction writer, and pioneering Hindi art critic. Known for his extensive writings on Indian art over five decades, his presence lent significant prestige to the event and served as a profound source of inspiration for the participating student artists. A particularly poignant highlight of the 23rd edition was a tribute to the beloved late Chancellor, Dr. Ashok Gupta. The event included the unveiling of his portrait and a relief, presented as a deeply felt token of gratitude. This year's exhibition featured the vibrant creativity of 138 students from the BFA and MFA programs, who collectively contributed approximately 2000 artworks.



Guest Lecture

The Department of Education of IIS (Deemed to be University), organized an engaging and thought-provoking session on "AI and Education: Preserving Human Agency in a World of Automation" on 8th November. The resource persons for the event were Mr. Ram Raika and Mr. Rahul Singh, founders of Unstoppable 20, renowned for their inspiring work in uplifting underprivileged street children through education. The introductory address highlighted the growing importance of Artificial Intelligence (AI) in today's education system and the need to balance technological advancement with human creativity and empathy.

Mr. Ram Raika and Mr. Rahul Singh discussed how Unstoppable 20 was founded with the mission of empowering learners through compassion and innovation. They explained how technology can support the teaching process but stressed that emotional connection and moral guidance, the qualities unique to human educators cannot be replaced by machines. Their examples from ground-level education projects helped the audience understand the real-world impact of human involvement in learning.



Admission Outreach

The Admission & Outreach Team of IISU proudly participated in the Great Education Expo 2026 (GEE) organized by Hi-Tech Education Services at Jodhpur.
