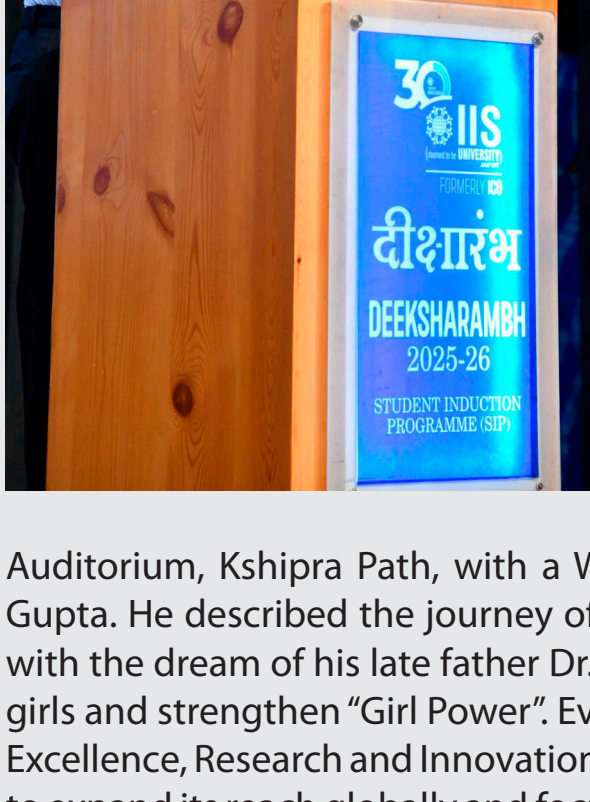




# CAMPUS SCOPE

## Deeksharambh



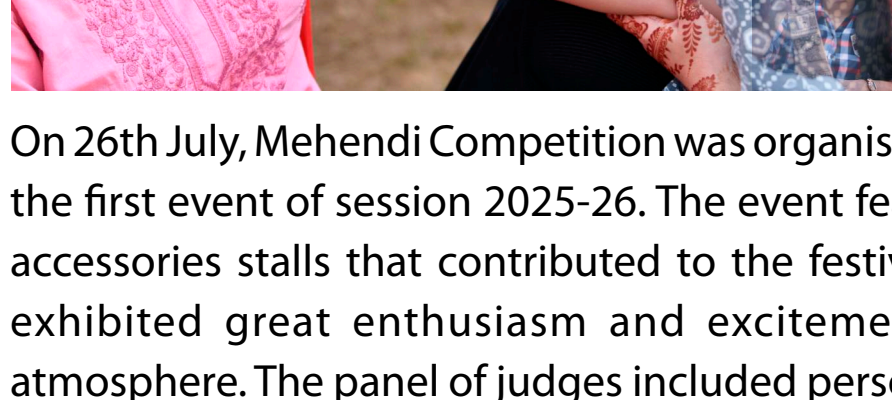
**A** Student Induction Programme was conducted at IIS (deemed to be) University from 9th July to 14th August. ## YOUNG MINDS BIG IDEAS

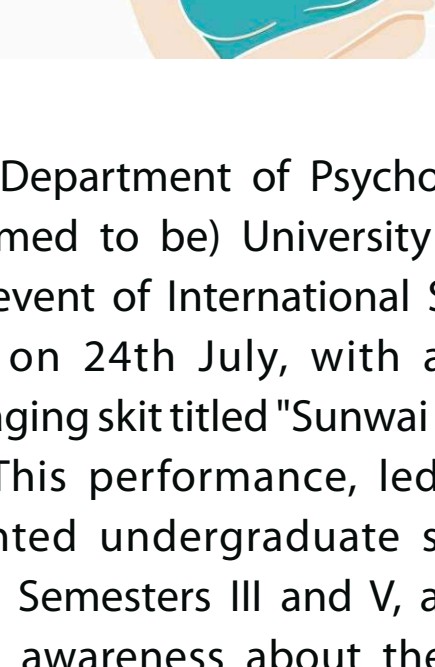

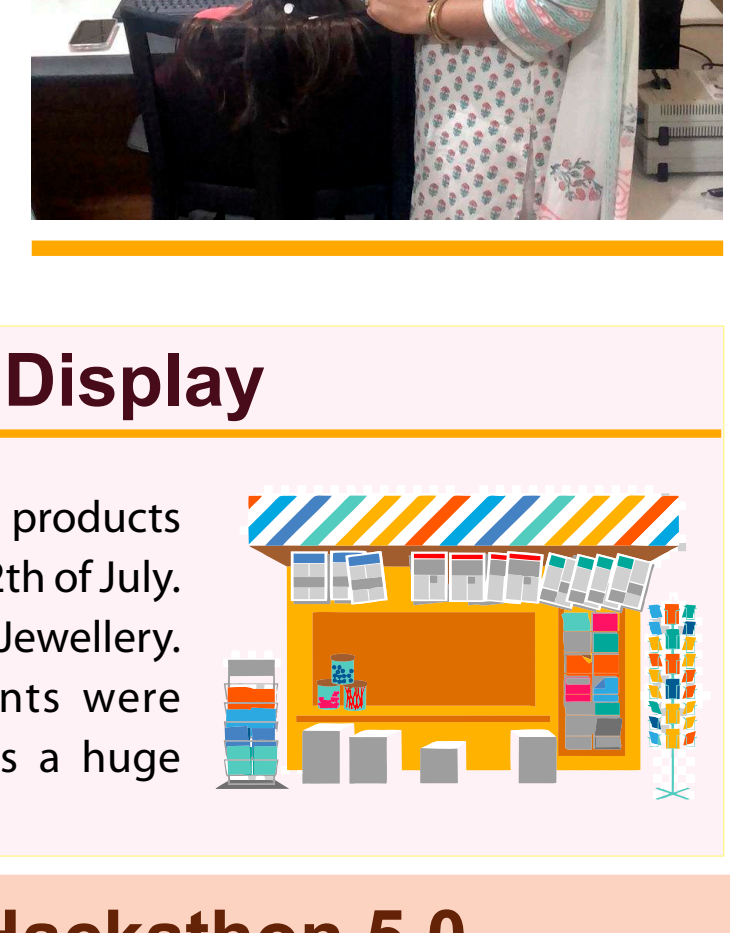

## Visit To Behavioural Lab

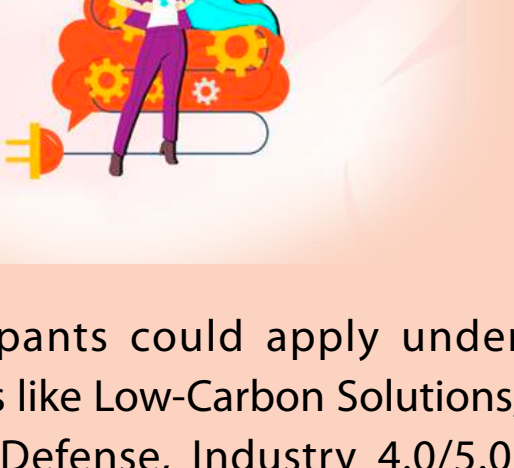
