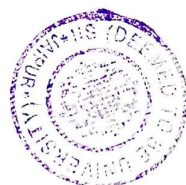

### **Objective of the Session:**

The primary objective of the session was to create awareness among faculties about the **Raj COP Citizen App**, an initiative by Rajasthan Police aimed at ensuring safety and providing quick support in emergencies, especially for women. The demonstration aimed to empower faculties with the knowledge and practical usage of the app for enhancing their personal security.

### **Summary/Description:**

The Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) organized a demonstration session on the **Raj COP Citizen App** on 27th May 2025 in the Meeting Room from 12:30 PM to 1:30 PM. The session was conducted by **Dr. Ankita Jain**, Professor, Department of Management Studies, IIS (Deemed to be University), Jaipur.

Dr. Ankita Jain began the session by introducing the app and highlighting its significance in preventing and addressing gender-based violence. She explained the core features of the app, including emergency SOS alerts, real-time location tracking, police contact integration, and citizen reporting.

Faculties were guided through the step-by-step process of downloading, installing, and registering on the app. Live demonstrations were conducted to help faculties understand how to use the emergency response options effectively.

The interactive session included a Q&A round where faculties actively raised queries about the app's usage and practical scenarios.

### **Outcome:**

The faculties gained hands-on knowledge of the **Raj COP Citizen App** and its functionalities. The session enhanced awareness regarding **digital safety tools** and the importance of being prepared in case of emergencies. Faculties expressed appreciation for the initiative and felt more confident about their personal safety and how technology can support gender-based violence prevention.

Download functionality was also discussed as a significant step toward police accountability and citizen empowerment.

Dr. Sharma spent considerable time explaining the innovative Tenant/Servant Verification system, which helps residents verify the backgrounds of domestic help or tenants through police records. She described this as an excellent example of preventive policing that enhances community safety. The app's directory of Helplines for specialized services (Child, Women, Cyber Crime, and Tele Manas) was presented as another valuable resource for citizens.

The lecture also covered practical features like locating Nearest Police Stations/Hospitals and the unique Calendar for Important Police Events, which keeps citizens informed about community policing initiatives. Dr. Sharma emphasized how these features collectively create a more engaged and informed citizenry.

While praising the app's innovative approach, Dr. Sharma also addressed potential challenges including digital literacy barriers in rural areas, data privacy concerns, and the need for continuous technical upgrades. She suggested that Rajasthan Police should conduct awareness campaigns and digital training sessions to maximize the app's reach and effectiveness.

The session concluded with an interactive Q&A where students raised thoughtful questions about cybersecurity measures, the app's adoption rate, and plans for future enhancements. Dr. Sharma's responses demonstrated her deep understanding of both technological and social aspects of digital policing solutions.

This guest lecture proved exceptionally valuable in demonstrating how digital tools like RajCOP Citizen are revolutionizing traditional policing methods. Dr. Sharma's expertise made complex concepts accessible, while her balanced perspective – acknowledging both the app's potential and its challenges – provided attendees with a comprehensive understanding of this significant digital governance initiative. The department looks forward to organizing more such informative sessions that bridge the gap between academic knowledge and real-world technological applications in governance and public safety.

**Objective of the Session:**

The primary objective of the session was to educate participants about the features and functionalities of the RajCOP Citizen app developed by Rajasthan Police.

1. To highlight how digital tools like RajCOP enhance public safety, transparency, and police-citizen collaboration.
2. To discuss the challenges and opportunities in implementing tech-driven policing solutions in diverse communities.
3. To encourage civic engagement by demonstrating how citizens can actively contribute to community safety using the app.

**Summary/Description (max 500 words):**

The Department of Management Studies and IISU – Internal Complaints Committee organized an insightful guest lecture on 12 April 2025 featuring Dr. Pragya Sharma, who spoke about the innovative 'RajCOP Citizen' mobile application developed by the Rajasthan Police. The lecture provided students and faculty with valuable insights into how technology is transforming public safety and police-citizen interactions in Rajasthan.

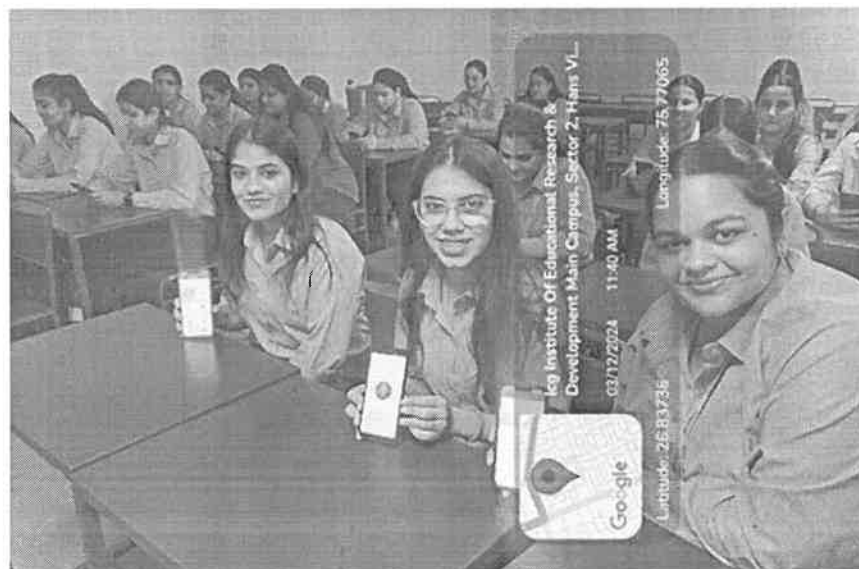
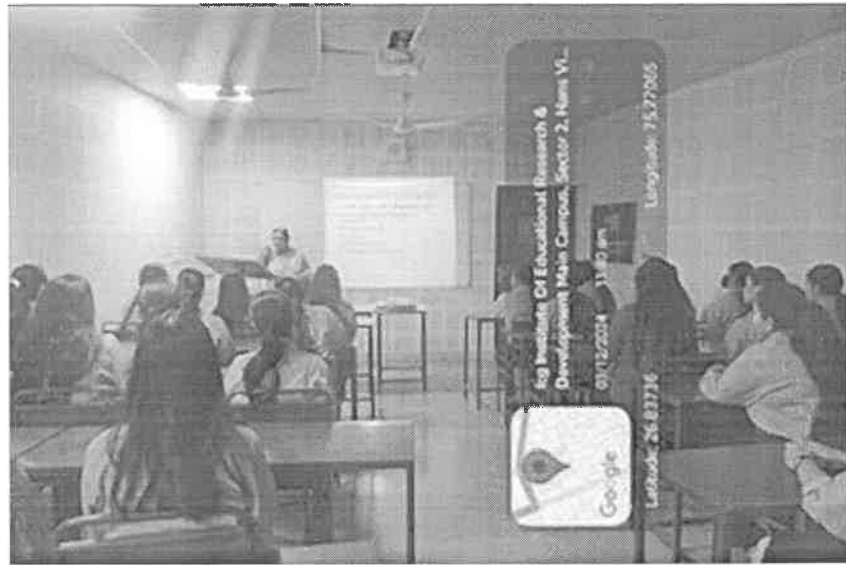
Dr. Sharma began her presentation by introducing the RajCOP Citizen app as a pioneering initiative under Rajasthan Police's digital transformation program. She explained that the app serves as a comprehensive platform designed to empower citizens while enhancing policing efficiency through technology. The lecture systematically covered all key features of the application, emphasizing its user-centric design and multiple functionalities.

One of the most critical features highlighted was the Emergency Help & RajCOP SOS system. Dr. Sharma demonstrated how this feature allows users to send immediate distress signals to the police with real-time location sharing, significantly reducing response times during emergencies. She particularly stressed the importance of the Travel Safety feature for women, explaining how it provides additional security layers for those traveling alone in the state.

The professor then detailed the app's Complaint Registration mechanism, which enables citizens to file complaints digitally and track their status in real-time. She noted how this feature brings transparency to police procedures while saving citizens from unnecessary visits to police stations. The FIR Access &

Students gained understanding of the women's rights against discrimination and the legal framework for ensuring safety and seeking solutions.



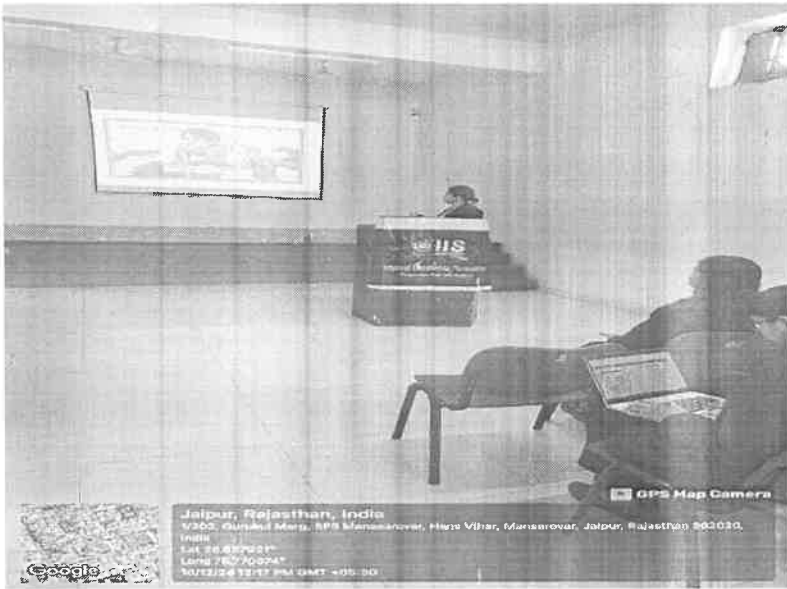
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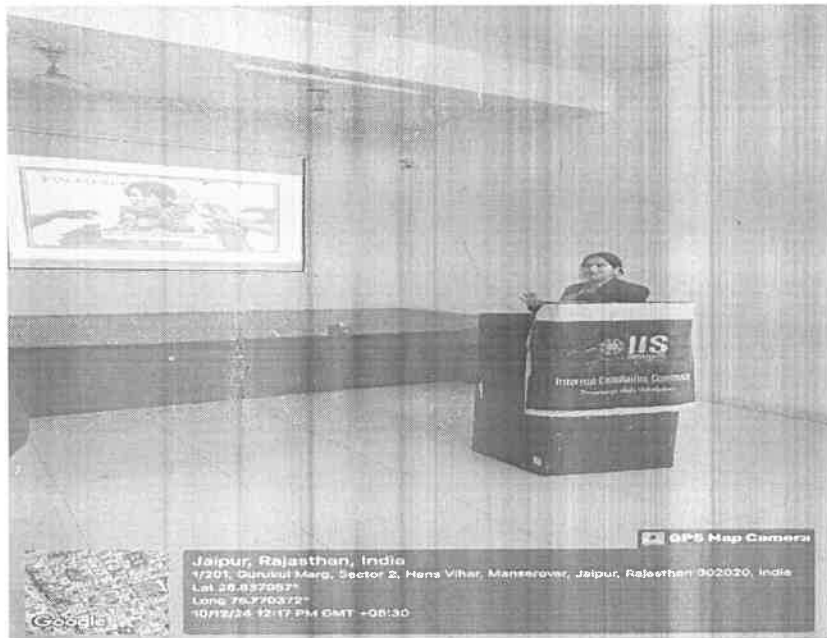

The primary objective of the session was to create awareness among students about the prevalence and impact of gender-based violence and to provide detailed information about emergency support services available in India

**Summary/Description (max 500 words):**

The awareness session, conducted by Dr. Vaishali Agrawal, was a comprehensive presentation focusing on eliminating gender-based violence and promoting the use of emergency response systems. Dr. Agrawal began by explaining the concept of gender-based violence, its various forms (physical, emotional, sexual, and economic), and its far-reaching consequences on individuals and society. She emphasized the importance of recognizing the signs of abuse, such as unexplained injuries, behavioral changes, and social isolation.

The session introduced students to three critical helpline services:

1. **Emergency Response (112):** A single number for police, fire, and medical assistance, operational 24/7 across India. Students were guided on how to use this service effectively during emergencies.
2. **Women Helpline (181):** A toll-free service dedicated to supporting women in distress. Dr. Agrawal elaborated on the services provided, including emotional support, legal guidance, and shelter assistance, assuring confidentiality and non-judgmental help.
3. **Child Line (1098):** A helpline for children in need of care and protection. The students learned about its role in rescuing children from exploitation, providing rehabilitation, and assisting runaway or homeless children.

Dr. Agrawal highlighted the university's initiatives to combat gender-based violence, including anti-harassment committees, awareness drives, and counseling services. She encouraged students to participate actively in these programs and to use their knowledge to create a safer environment on campus and beyond.

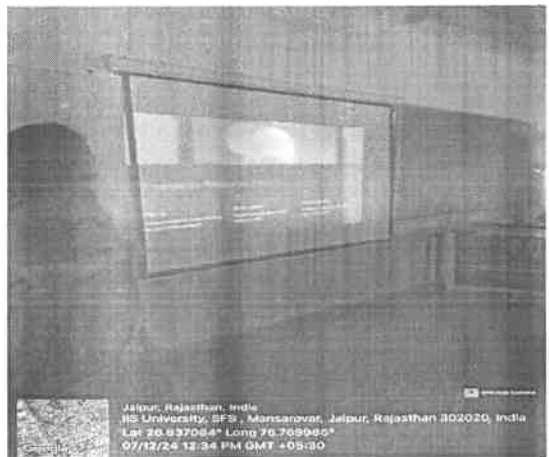
