Feedback-Analysis

Action Taken

Around 92% students have found the course to be Job Oriented; Approx 94% students found the course content to be knowledgeable and interesting. Around 84% felt that course was framed to meet today's market demands. About 86% students felt that ample Co-Curricular activities are conducted. Nearly 93% students are satisfied with the wide range of Extra-Curricular activities conducted in University. About 94% are likely to recommend the course to others.

None needed; the feedback was, however, shared by the Departments in the respective BOS Meetings for the members' information. The constitution of the BOS includes an alumna for the purpose of formalizing the seeking and recording of such feedback.

Analysis and Action-Taken for Compliance

Stakeholder-Feedback for design and review of syllabi is sought every year from the Alumnae, by the Alumnae Association, and analyzed centrally by the Feedback Monitoring Cell. If required, it is shared with the respective Departments for necessary action towards curriculum design and development.
