



Description of Webinar




Students got an insight to the actives being organized by CII –Yi – YUVA in association with IIS university in last few years wherein they had a glimpse to the youth conclave conducted in



Engineer by qualification.



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
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

and establish a new branch of psychology. Always looking for greater challenges, she is now training to become the youngest female triathlete in India.



Description:







Description:

The session was started by Mr. Arpit Patni, introducing about the CII and different Yi chapters and also stating the objective of the organization, followed by Ms Madhana Ratnavel who stated

the main objective of the session and introduced the topic to the attendees of the webinar. Next,

Mr Kushagra Juneja, introduced the speaker of this webinar and also gave the welcome speech .

The speaker of the webinar was Miss. Sheeba Sen, founder of Alaap, a social enterprise with a

mission to catalyse reforestation. She aims of bringing back the native forest by urban forest

techniques such as Miyawaki technique. She works for integrated reforestation projects and

Youth fellowship program. Firstly, she talked about climate change and what does it mean for


India. According to her, climate change mainly occurs due to rise in temperature level, disrupted


rainfall, extreme weather events and causes more diseases. She then stated about Miyawaki

forest. Miyawaki forest was first established in Japan by Dr. Akira Miyawaki who has planted more than 40,000,000 trees worldwide, at 1700 different locations. Miyawaki Forest aims at 30 times more denser forest building, 10 times more growth as compared to conventional forest, 100 times more bio- diverse and 100% natural. It focuses on multilayer green forest which include canopy layer, tree layer, sub-tree layer and shrub layer and grows 30 trees per 100 square feet with over 50 different native species. There are 6 steps to forest creation namely soil survey, native species and biomass survey, sampling preparation or procurement, preparation of soil and mound, plantation with community and maintenance and monitoring. The benefits of Miyawaki Forest are that it recharges water sources, addresses man-animal coexistence issue, increases bio-diversity, especially birds and insects, increase 10 time the rate of conventional methods. Lastly the session was ended by some Q&A by the attendees and vote of thanks by Mr Kushagra Juneja to the attendees and to Miss. Sheeba Sen for the wonderful and deep learning session.

Outcomes from the Event:

Students became aware about Miyawaki techniques.






