ABOUT CII Yi YUVA CLUB



Students from five institutions in Jaipur, namely IISU, Poornima University, Poornima Institute of Engineering & Technology, ICFAI Business School, and S.S. Jain Subodh PG College, were in attendance.

Following the welcome address, Mr. Rahul Kalani, Yuva Chair, Yi Jaipur, introduced the event to the audience, highlighting its role in voicing the opinions of young minds. He underscored that the workshop's outcomes would be documented and shared with the PMO. Subsequently, Mr. Rahul Singhi, Chair, Yi Jaipur, expressed gratitude to all organizers, mentors, and particularly IIS University for hosting the event. Mr. Vivek Lodha, Director of JVS Foods Pvt. Ltd. and an Angel Investor, then spoke about the topics of discussion, emphasizing the importance of early initiation for today's generation.

The stage was then taken by five mentors of different sessions. Mr. Namit Agarwal, mentor for the Future of Tech in Manufacturing, shared an insightful video on the growth of tech manufacturing. brainstorming ideas to address the issues in each segment.

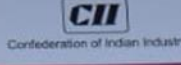
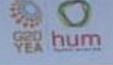
Outcome of the Activity:
