ZehlaSherwani cleared the AFC (Assistant Forest Conservator) written exam, 2021.

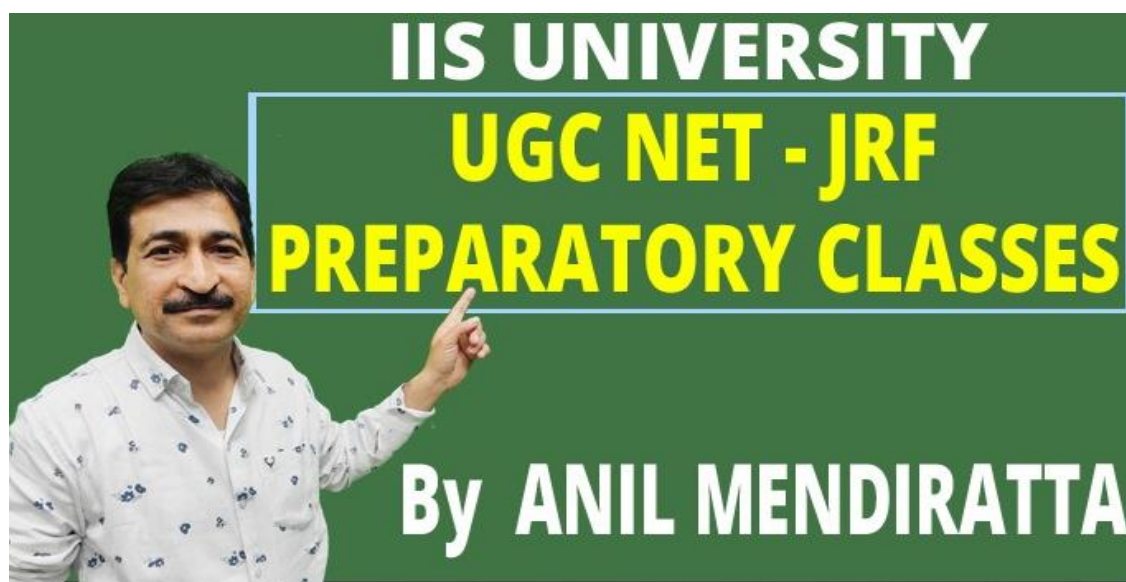
Ashneet Kaur cleared the AFCAT (Air Force Combined Admission Test) written exam 2021.

Pooja Choudhary cleared the CDS (Combined Defense Services) written exam 2021.

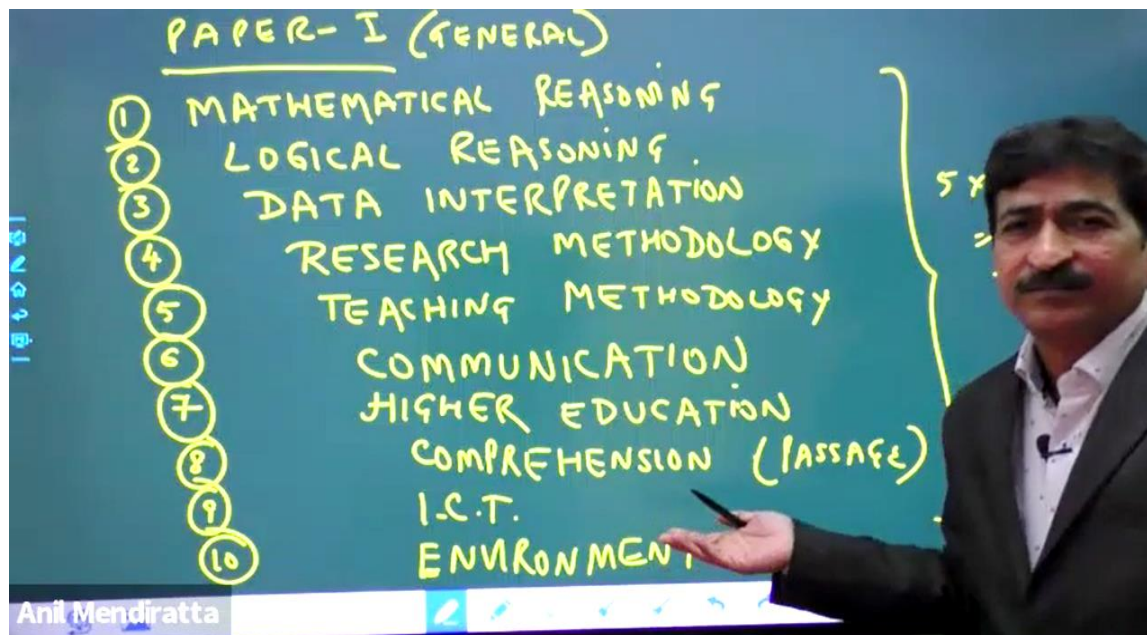
UGC NET-JRF Preparatory Classes
