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9TH ANNUAL FASHION SHOW 2018 creations



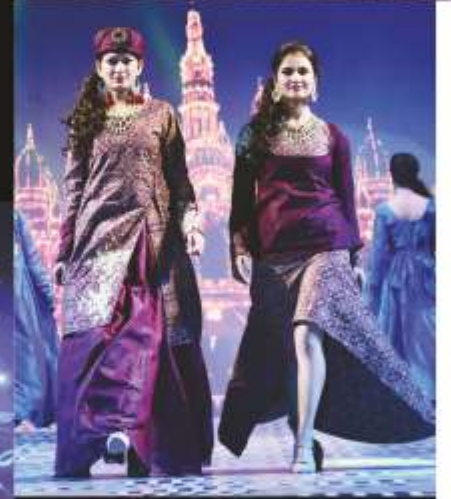
Ocean of feelings were expressed by designers at the 9th annual fashion show 'Creations-2018' organised by the department of Fashion and Textile Technology of The IIS Deemed to be University on 25th January 2018 at the lush green lawns of the IIS University. Mr. Jagdeesh Chandra, CEO, Zee Regional Channels was present as the Chief Guest on the occasion while Celebrity Fashion Designer Mr. Hemant Trivedi was the Guest of Honor. The fashion show witnessed collection in Ten different themes. A total of 27 students cum fashion designers showcased the outfits donned by 42 students cum models. Television Actor Mansi Jain graced the occasion as a special invitee while Ms. Jaykirti Singh, Designer Jaipur and Fashion Designer Ms. Avneet Adwani had donned the judges' hats.





The designers dared to deviate from the usual perception of blue for boys and pink for girls and launched their breathtaking collection "Borrowed from the Boys". Designers Sakshi Khanna, Shristi Gupta, Snigdha Jain and Vidhi Lunawat created a blend of business wear for men and street wear for women and proved that blue and grey color can also look good on women. A touch of femininity was bestowed upon the menswear using details and design embellishments. The designer Purna Agarwal depicted the nine emotions of women through her collection "Navaras", wherein Pink portrayed love, Red rendered anger, Black figured fear, Yellow delineated joy, Grey explained sadness, Brown imitated disgust, Blue profiled wonder and Orange silhouetted Bravery. The event culminated recognizing the tireless toils of the bold couturier and accord on the well deserved awards under different categories.

GEN NEXT DESIGNER was awarded to the collection "Madras Cafe" by Solo Designer Aditi Vyas, which



showcased Madras lungi checks in fashion, playing with colors and fabric such as tissue to give a trendy look that stands out from far. OUTSTANDING DESIGN COLLECTION title was granted to the collection "Borrowed from the Boys".



SPECIAL JURY AWARD was received by Designers Aishwarya Rathore, Jahanvi Badlani and Jyoti Yadav's Collection "London Talkies" looks to London as it mused with its red bus and phone booth. Borrowed from landscapes, the designers presented a blend of chic and classic fashion wear. The designers used screen painting, printing etc to create this look which was applauded by the audience.

Innovative Design Award was bestowed upon the Designers Kritika Mittal, Mallika Mittal, Riddhi Gupta and Shivani Jain for their collection "Stately Surprise" which showcased Orissa's woven fabric Ikat in everyday women's fashion with its lush layers and dreamy drapes.

Workshop on 'Question Framing Technique for Faculty of Arts & Social Sciences'

A two-day workshop on 'Question Framing Technique for Faculty of Arts & Social Sciences' was organized by the IIS University, Jaipur on 27-28 January, 2018. Eighty faculty members and seventeen resource persons from Arts & Social Sciences participated in the workshop. The inaugural ceremony began with Saraswati Vandana followed by lighting the lamp to seek divine blessings, after which Prof. N.K. Jain, Dean Arts & Social Sciences apprised the gathering on the objectives of the workshop. The Keynote speaker, Prof. Sudha Rao, Former Vice Chancellor, Karnataka State Open University, Mysore emphasized the role of a good and a bad teacher in the framing of a student's personality and spoke at length on taxonomy which plays a vital role in making learning interesting, elaborating upon the terms 'Course Outcome', 'Course Purpose' and 'Expected Outcome'. She concluded her address marking that a course should instill critical thinking in writing. Prof. N.K. Jain, Dean Faculty of Arts & Social Sciences presented mementos to the key note speaker Prof. Sudha Rao and welcomed the resource person Prof. Vimla Veera Raghavan, Emeritus Professor (Psychology), Psychology SOSS, IGNOU, New Delhi. Prof. Rao discussed about various cognitive levels of Bloom's taxonomy like



remembering, understanding, applying, analyzing, evaluation and creation. She threw light on various aspects of conceptual, procedural and meta-cognitive knowledge, concluding that instruction needs to pay attention to cognitive, affective and psychomotor domains. The session was highly interactive and



enriching as the expertise of the Resource Persons provided new insights into the significance and processes of outlining the same with clarity and precision as its major objectives.



BOARD OF STUDIES MEETINGS

The IIS University accredits itself with foremost responsibility of upgrading the course content as to accomplish the objective of high quality research and value its ongoing engagement and external collaboration. The University values the freedom of flexibility in designing the syllabus and evaluation system, consequently holds board of studies meeting every year for various departments. The

This year too, the University initiated the BOS sessions in the month of January which will last till the month of March. The process, besides upgrading the course content, allows the faculty to suggest changes in the curricula and serve as nexus between the academia and industry interface.

National Conference on “Global Approaches in Nutrition, Inclusive Education and Textile Science”



Department of Home Science, The IIS University organized a two day National Conference on “Global Approaches in Nutrition, Inclusive Education and Textile Science” on 2nd-3rd February 2018. Prof. Jagmeet Madan, Principal, SVT College of Home Science, SNDT University, Mumbai, Vice President Indian Dietetic Association and India Representative Asian Federation of Dietetic Association, was warmly welcomed as the Key Note Speaker. Other eminent speakers were Ms Rekha Sharma, Retd. Chief Dietician AIIMS, New Delhi, Country Representative and Director International Confederation of Dietetic Associations, Mr Somesh Singh, Co-Founder Craft Village, New Delhi, Dr Deepak Kalra, Director, Umang, Jaipur to name a few. The Technical Sessions were apportioned over two days, alongside 23 oral and 83 Poster presentations sufficing in the three streams of Home Science, further highlighting a global movement towards Nutrition, Inclusive Education and Textile Science. Two hundred and twenty members participated in the conference, with nine invited lectures, shared through three technical sessions.
