
Sponsored by ICHR, a two-day National Conference on "Re (Visiting) History, Nation and Culture through Autobiography, Biography and Memoirs" was organised on 12-13 January, 2018 by the Department of History, Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences, The IIS University, Jaipur to debate on the emerging trends, challenges and modern approaches in reading the narratives. The conference comprised eight sessions exploring the conventional patterns of reading the non-conventional literary sources.
