



IIS (DEEMED TO BE UNIVERSITY) CELEBRATES SEVENTH CONVOCATION CEREMONY



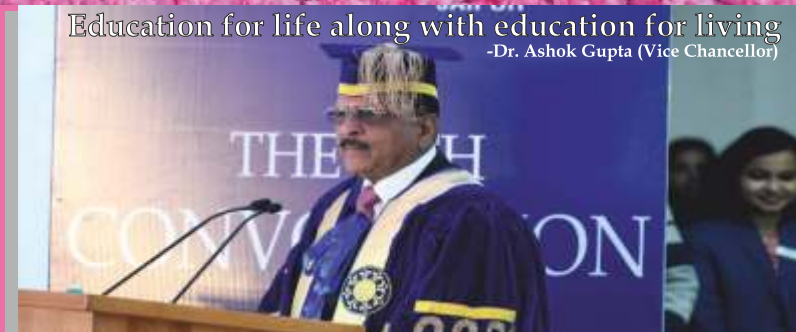

IIS University holds All India Inter University Volleyball Woman Tournament



On Sunday, 20th December 2018, the Jaipurite dilettantes of women volleyball witnessed a thrilling match conducted by IIS (Deemed to be University) in association with All India Inter-University, New Delhi. The tournament was organised in Sawai Mansingh Stadium, Jaipur. The event was inaugurated by carol singing Saraswati Vandana, followed by the words of the Vice Chansellor of the University, Mr. Ashok Gupta, wherein he welcomed the esteemed guests and emphasized on the importance of sports as well significance of healthy competition in a sports person's life. The Stadium echoed with roars, cheers and hooting powered with great energy seeing the players' enthusiasm, passion and commitment for the game. Each of the teams was worth winning the tournament but on a certain day one excels the other blessed by Providence. The match was played between Kurukshetra University and MG University, Kottayam on

Thursday, 24th December, and Kurukshetra, in the initial stage took a straight lead of two sets with scores of 25-17, 25-13, over MG University Kottayam. It seemed as if Kurukshetra's win was a foregone conclusion. But Kottayam came back with an added verve and made Kurukshetra succumb, scoring 25- 21 and 26 – 24, in the next two sets. Both teams thus, after 4 sets, were equally placed. The outcome depended on the final set of 15 points where Kurukshetra, showing their ingenuity, went all out with their might and were able to overcome Kottayam with a score of 15 – 06, to be crowned as winners of The All-India Inter-University (Women) Tournament, 2019. The Punjab University banged the second runner-up position, while the MG University stood as the first runner-up. International players like Lavanaya, Aenna Methew from MG University, Neha and Sukhveer Kaur from Kurukshetra University are part of International team as well as Punjab University player Shivani holds captaincy of Junior Indian Team. Moving forward with event, Registrar of IIS University Dr Rakhi Gupta presented momentum to the chief guests and proposed vote of thanks to all the participating institutes and dear guests for being part of this amazing volleyball championship. She stressed upon the necessity of making sports an elementary part of educational programme for making the lifestyle healthy and productive. Lastly she said that she believes students will play the game with full dedication and discipline. Furthermore, that Participation was more important than winning or loosing. Inaugural ceremony discharged by administrating oath to the players through Navodita Singh.
