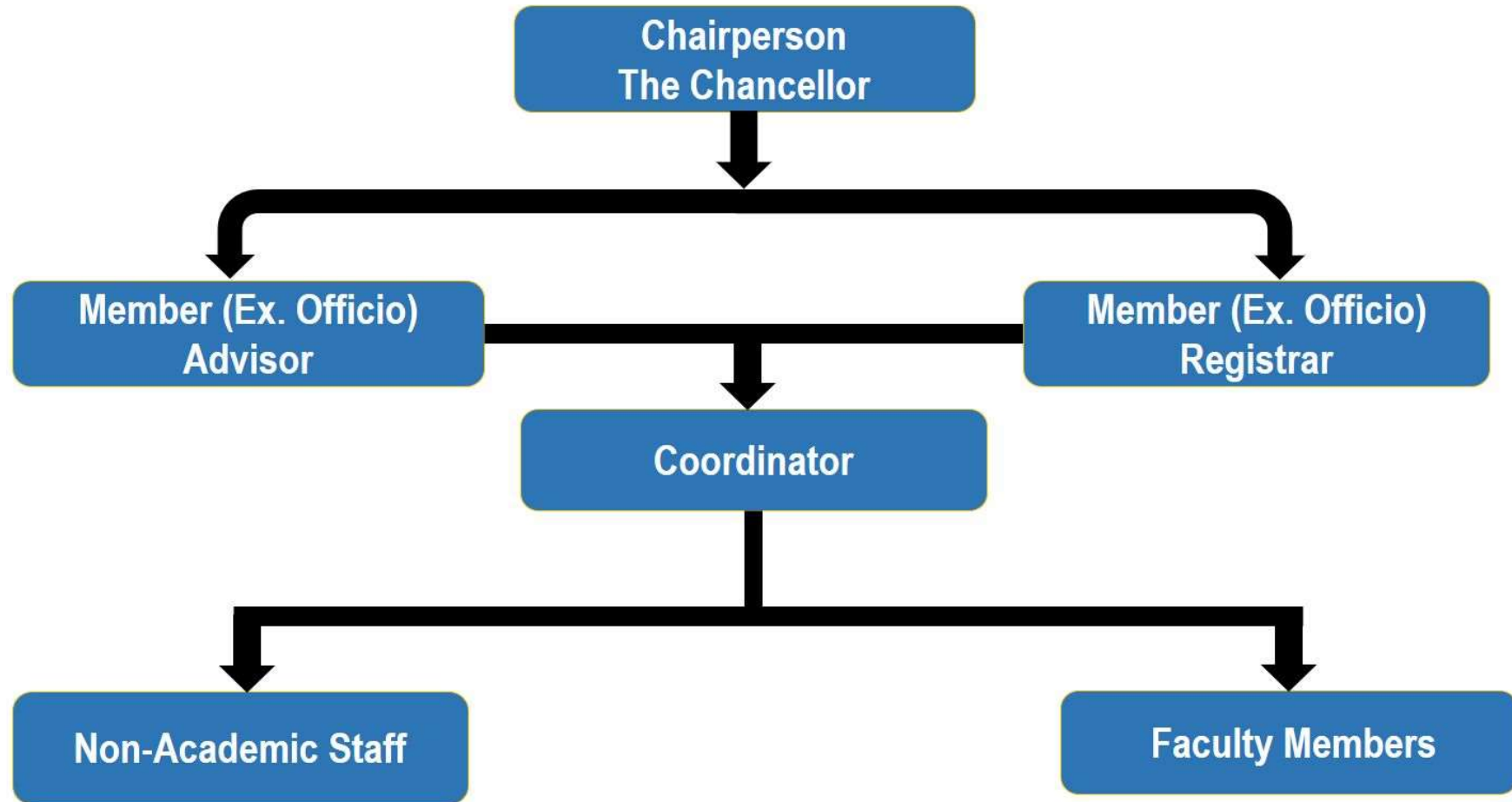
IISU and Global Vision

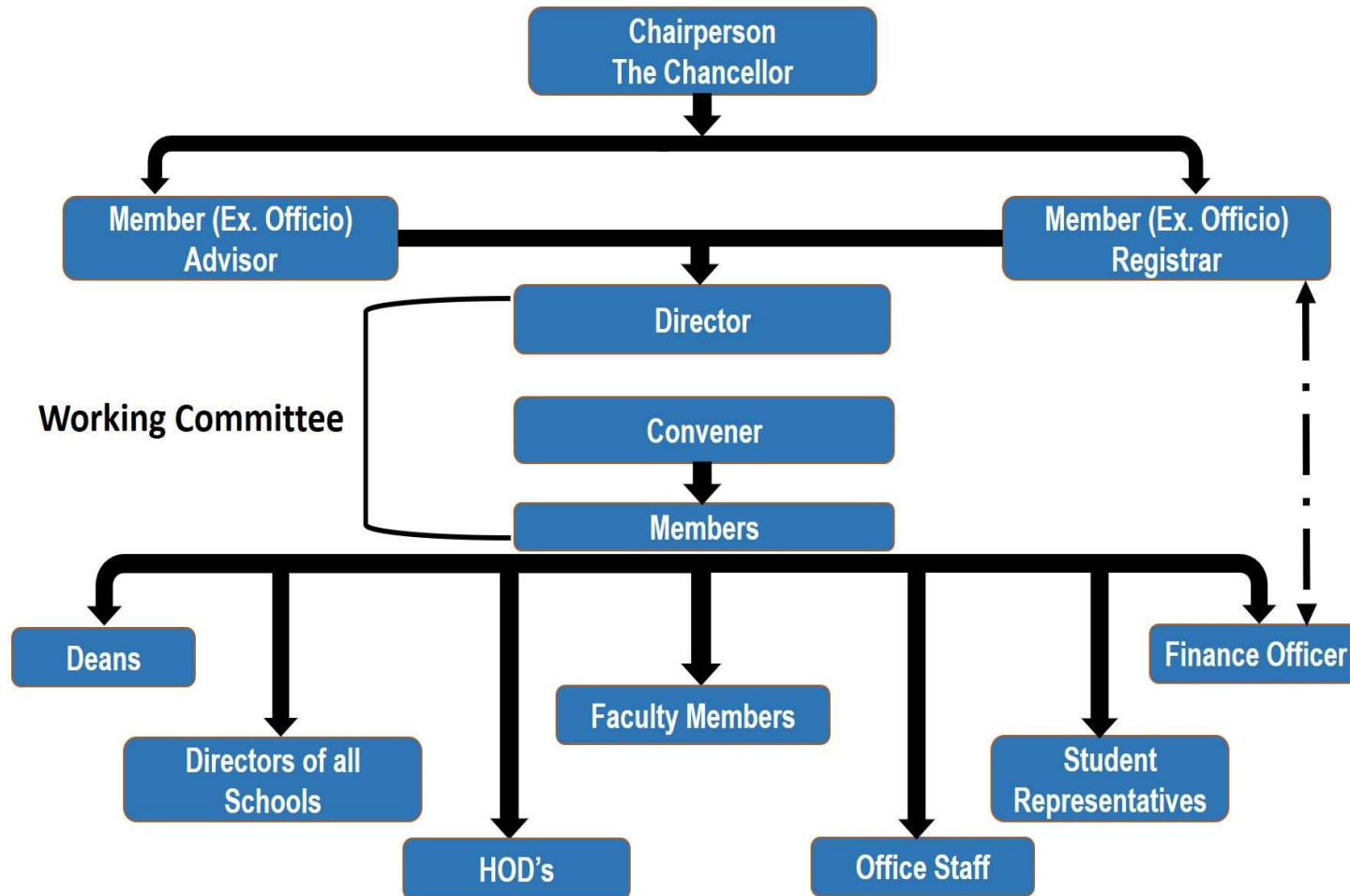

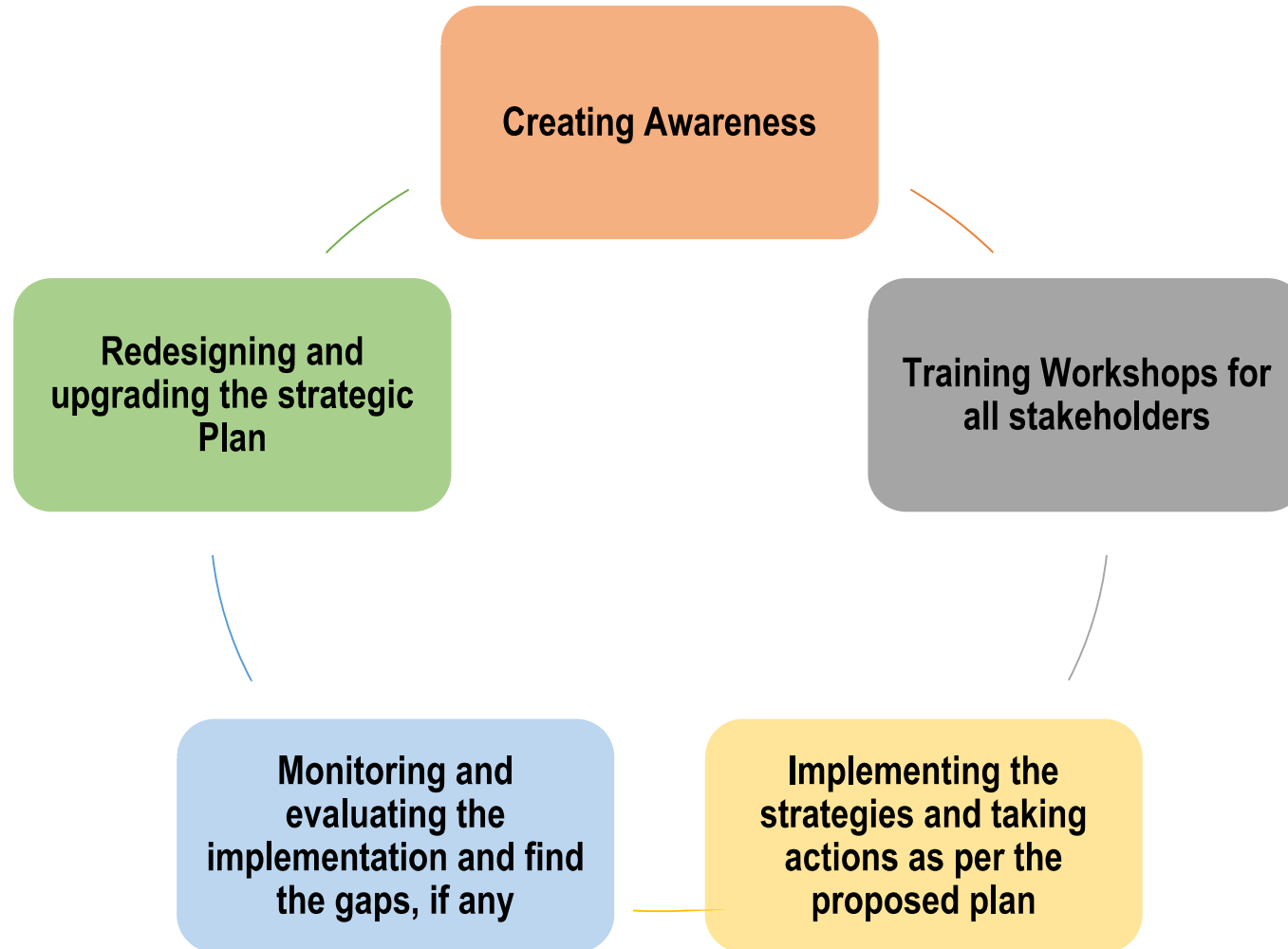


The arrows represents the information and documentation flow.
